

The fourth mohair sale of the 2026 summer selling season performed well again. Although HF quoted the market as unchanged compared to the previous sale, it is still highly satisfactory at this price level. All the buyer houses competed well, with the big highlight of the HF sale being the R1 110.00/kg for the top summer kid bale of Martin & Hein Truter (DIE WIEG BOERDERY) of the Oudtshoorn district. This super style, B-length bale of 21.9 micron, and a clean yield of 92%, was the best quality offered this year so far. This bale was entered in the industry competition. Another bale that was entered belongs to Richard Herold of Graaff-Reinet. This super style bale of 22.1 micron was sold at R930.10/kg! Standard Wool bought both bales. There are only three sales left for the season. One in April, one in May and one in June. These three sales are well known for the top producers' clips, which will be offered on these sales. HF is confident that we are going to see more record prices for summer kids. The tone of this sale was that there is a slight resistance against the price of the stronger component of the clip. The future will tell us if this tendency continues. The sale sizes are expected to be remarkably similar with the next sale offered on the 21st of April in Port Elizabeth.
