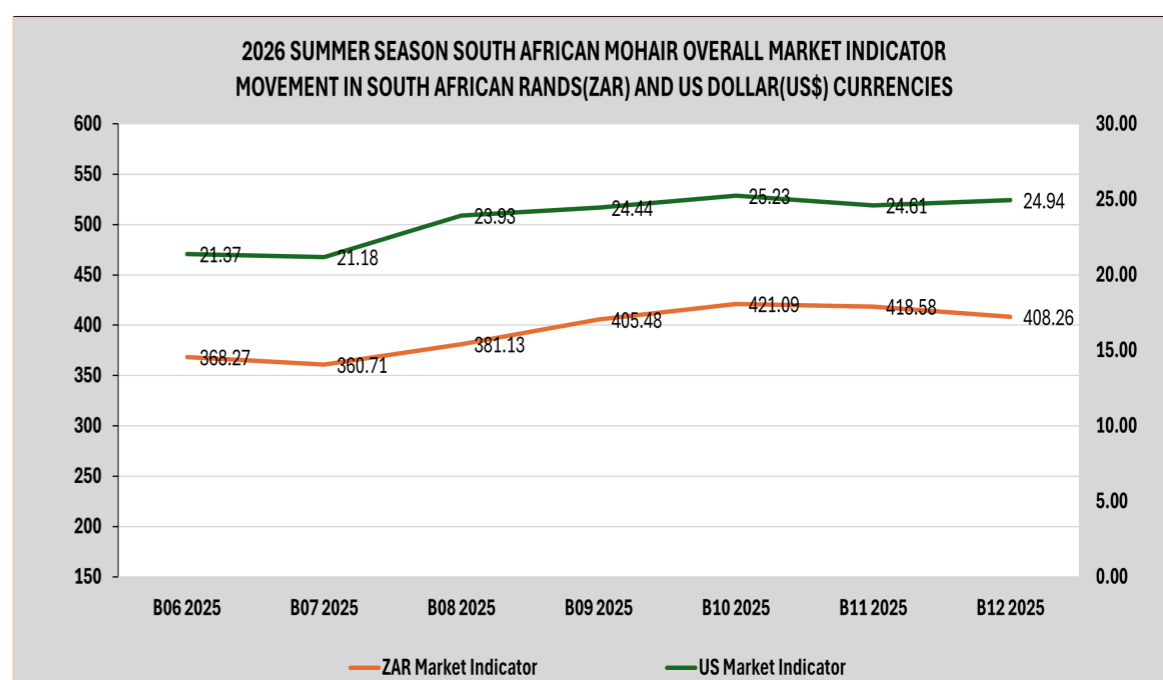

The fifth mohair sale of the 2026 summer selling season created quite a buzz with a big offering of very high-quality kid mohair. All the major processors fight to get a quantity of these top bales. In the process, the 8-year-old world record of R1 256.10/kg for a bale of trophy mohair offered by Van Hasselt Farming, Prince Albert, in 2018, was broken for the first time when the best bale of Robert and Michael Bosch (Rietfontein Familie Boerdery) of Somerset East sold for R1261.00/kg! This super style, B-length, 24.6-micron bale with a clean yield of 90.9% were special and should perform well in the competition for the best bale in 2026. The Bosch's second bale, testing 22 micron, sold for R1 100.00/kg! The downside of the sale was that the good general demand by all buyers faded away, forcing the two big processing buyers to buy the bulk of the offering again. Although the kid market improved with 1%, the young goat component came down with 5% and adults with 3%. There was a resistance building up against the decent prices for young goats. This component has increased in price by about 20% since February. The strengthening of the Rand against the USA\$, with more than 4%, also did not help. On the next sale on 12 May, the other top clips of the country will be on sale, including the clip of Jordi van Hasselt, trying his best to get his world record back!
