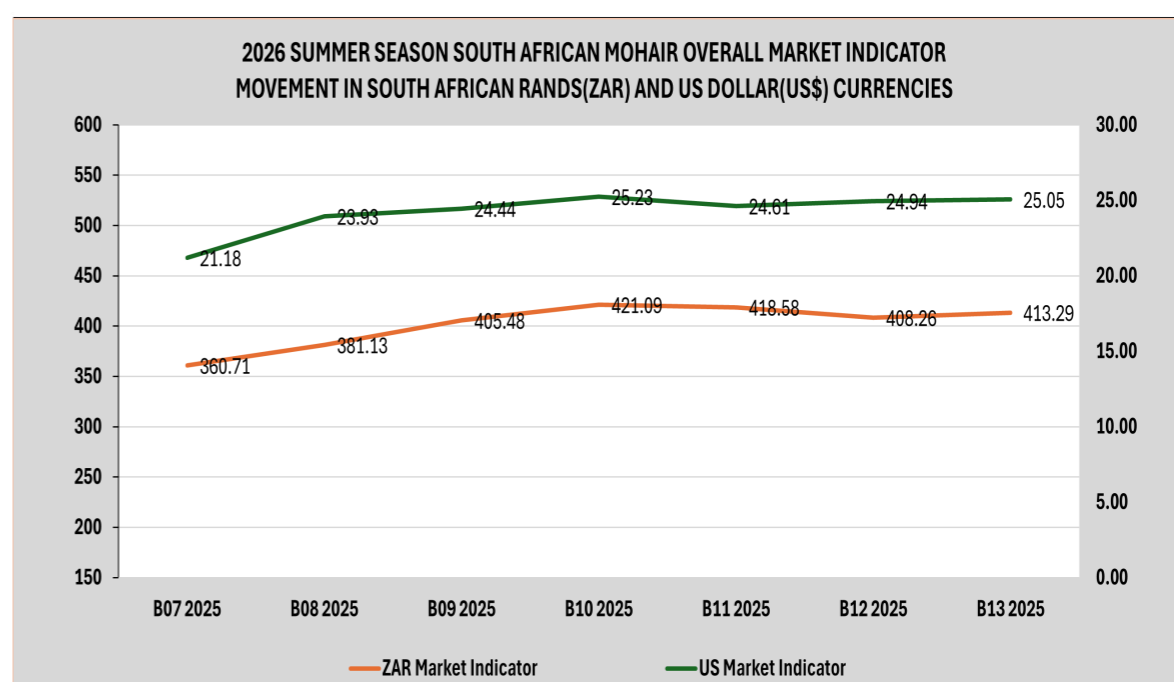

The second-to-last mohair sale of the 2026 summer selling season was something special. Some of the best bales ever seen were presented for sale. All the major processors fight to get a quantity of these top bales. The 8-year-old world record of Van Hasselt Farming that was broken by Rietfontein Familie Boerdery of Somerset East at R1261.00/kg on the previous sale 3 weeks ago, was claimed back by Van Hasselt Farming, Prince Albert at R1 330.00/kg! A new world record. The super bale of Michau Nortje of Willowmore equalled this record only a few minutes later! The record holders now are Van Hasselt Farming, Michau Nortje, and Fred Colborne. These bales were bought by Paul Lynch of the Standard Wool company for a specialised processor in Italy. The technical team at HF confirmed that the quality of clips has exceeded that of the best ever offered. Although the market is quoted as 1.2% up, HF see the market as largely unchanged. It was the better quality that made the difference. The last sale of the 2026 summer season will be offered on the 2nd of June at the Mohair Exchange. This sale is surprisingly big, caused by shearing teams that were held up by good rainfall. Also, a lot of very high-quality bales are on offer.
