The market traded on an overall softer tone, but the 18.0 micron and finer segment is beginning to show the momentum the industry has been waiting for. In contrast, the 19.5 micron and stronger categories lost some traction as buyer demand shifted back toward the superfine end of the offering.

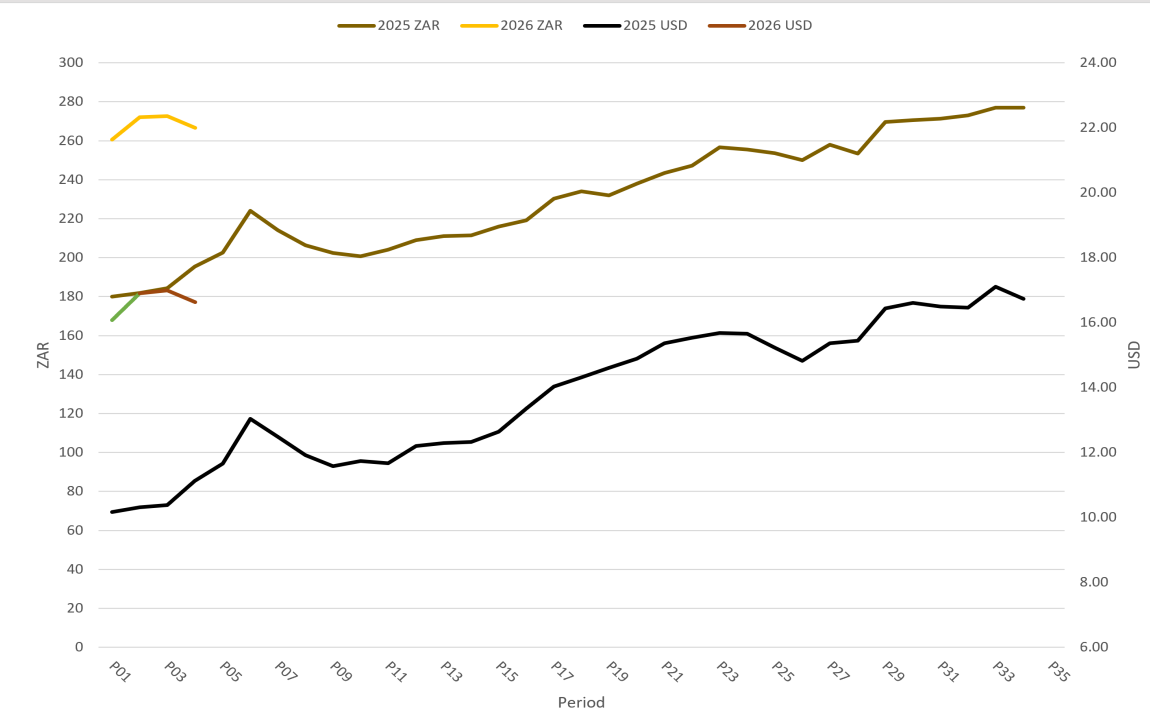

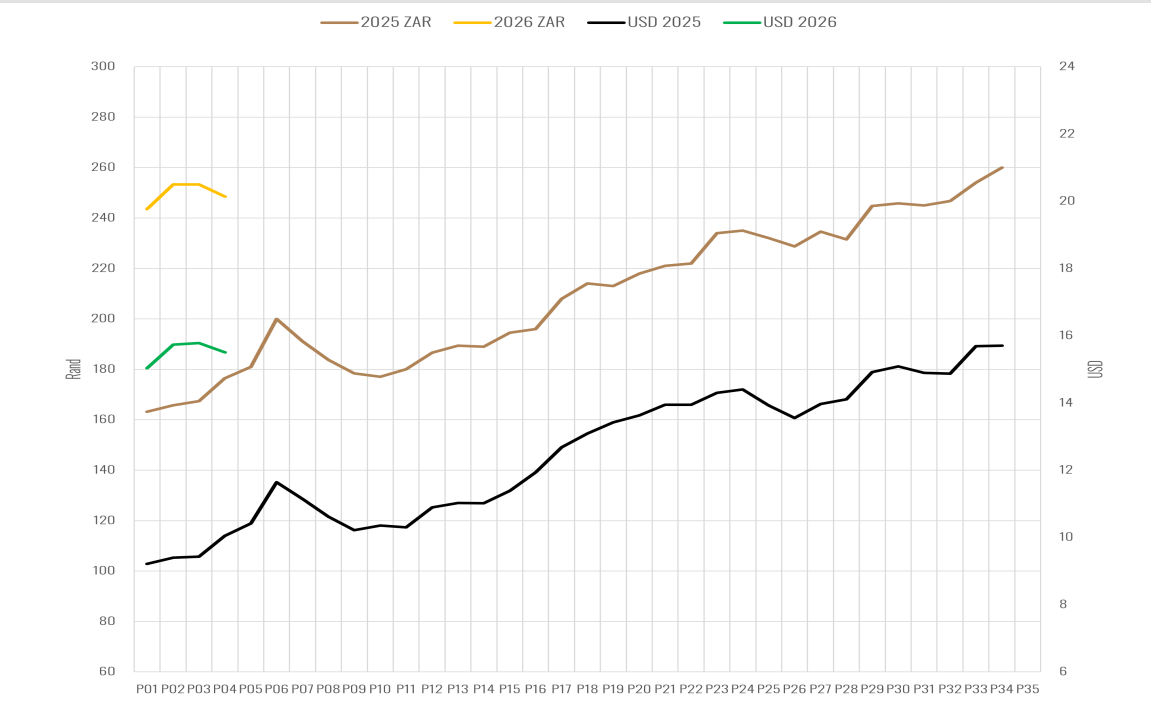
