

The last mohair sale of the 2025 summer selling season still saw good demand for fine kids, but young goats and adults came under price pressure. This was caused by the fact that the two processing buyers were still forced to buy most of the mohair. The moment the big bulk was on offer, the price came down. The fact that the Rand kept on strengthening does not help either. The day's highlight was the seasonal record price for summer kids paid for the bale of, Ray and Donna Hobson from Steytlerville. This super style, B-length bale tested 22 microns, with a clean yield of 85.4% and was sold for R930.00/kg to an Italian spinner, specializing in super fine mohair. The fact that the kid market ended the season so strong, is a good omen for the coming winter season. It will be worth the farmers' while to get their winter kids tested to identify the fine mohair. The price differences are vast. The first sale of the winter season will be on the 19th of August. We close the scale for this sale on the 18th of July.
