

The fourth mohair sale of the 2023 winter selling season, felt the effects of the turmoil in the world's politics and economies. The sale's figures of 81% sold and the market only 3% down, does not look too bad. The concerning fact is that only two buyers were in operation, and towards the end, it became evident that they had run out of money. The downward trend of kids was also an unpleasant surprise. Nevertheless, the top-quality clips still excelled. We rarely discuss clip averages, as they can be easily manipulated, but in this sale, is worth mentioning. Sarel du Plessis from Oudtshoorn sold 85% of his clip at an average price of R437.70/kg (clip entered for Miyuki Competition). Sarel's top bale also fetched the second-best price of R706.00/kg! In second place, Martin & Hein Truter, also from Oudtshoorn, averaged R391.12/kg with 100% sold! In third place, Flip & Phillip Schutte from Rietbron averaged R350.10/kg (96%) sold) (clip entered for Miyuki Competition) and achieved the best individual price of the day at R710.00/kg for their best bale of super kids. The next sale will be similar in size and held on the 31st of October in the Port Elizabeth International Mohair Exchange.
